WHITE WINE

VERY DRY, DELICATE, LIGHT WHITES

- 1 **Solandia Grillo, Terre Siciliane, Italy** £3.50 £5.85 £16.95
The sun-loving grape of Sicily offers a melange of tropical fruit flavours followed by light almond and dried peaches.
- 2 **Moon River Pinot Grigio, Hungary** £3.90 £6.25 £17.95
The UK is increasingly falling in love with the well-made, excellent value wines from Hungary, and this is a prime example. Refreshing pinot grigio made from grapes grown overlooking the Danube River, producing a light, soft, refreshing wine with lemon and apple flavours and a hint of herbs.
- 3 **Rioja Blanco, El Coto, Rioja, Spain** £4.00 £6.75 £20.50
A zingy and refreshing white rioja with flavours of fresh peach, melon, bramley apple and tropical fruits.
- 4 **Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine de la Serre, South France** £20.50
Picpoul is fast-becoming one of the UK's most fashionable wines, and this bottle's zippy freshness, ripe fruit and mineral backbone shows exactly why. Try a glass on a sunny day, or pair it with some tasty fish.
- 5 **Domaine La Roche Chablis 'St Martin', France** £33.00
An exceptional, ripe, fresh and refined Chardonnay with textbook Chablis minerality and complexity thanks to the estate's fantastic vineyard plots. St Martin is the patron saint of Chablis, and his relics were kept at this family-run domaine's monastery for many years. A truly elegant wine – one to linger over.

DRY, HERBACEOUS OR AROMATIC WHITES

- 6 **Amalaya Torrontes, Argentina** £19.95
A dry and delicate white with great freshness hints of citrus and grapefruit, crisp acidity and a distinctly mineral finish.
- 7 **Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand** £22.95
An absolute classic from the popular Marlborough region of New Zealand: crisp, aromatic and packed full of typical grassy, zesty lime and gooseberry character.
- 8 **Made by award winning winery in Kent-Chapel Down Bacchus White, England** £28.50
Ripe melon, peach, passion fruit, gooseberry and a hint of cut grass on the nose: the palate shows tropical fruits and refreshing lime.

JUICY FRUIT - DRIVEN, RIPE WHITES

- 9 **Caoba Viognier, Mendoza, Argentina** £18.95
A lighter, yet full flavoured style of Viognier. The nose leaps out of the glass with aromas of ripe stone fruit. Flavours of peach and apricot are followed by a subtle sweet spice with a lingering finish.
- 10 **Organic Fiano, Sicily, Italy** £23.95
Wonderfully bright and expressive with rich aromas and bags of tropical fruit. Bright and expressive, this has a soft mouthfeel and great purity. Zensa in Italian means "without" referring to the absence of any chemicals or pesticides in the winemaking process.
- 11 **El Cante Albariño, Spain** £25.50
The popular albariño grape is the ultimate seafood companion from Rias Baixas, the beating heart of this grape's homeland in the Galicia region of Spain. Light and zesty with rounded stone fruits - very sippable and then re number the bins please

FULL-FLAVOURED, NUTTY, OAKED WHITES

- 12 **Montes Alpha Casablanca Chardonnay, Chile** £29.95
This exceptional winemaking estate in the cool Casablanca Valley has carefully crafted a rich, ripe, tropical Chardonnay with some buttery, vanilla hints from a short time in oak, and a lingering, luxurious finish. Perfect with baked brie.

- 13 **Prosecco Corte Alta, NV, DOC, Italy** £4.25 £5.95 £22.95
A perfect example of why Prosecco is so popular right now – delicate, fresh and frothy, with soft, accessible peach and pear flavours. A revitalising treat – go on, you deserve it.
- 14 **Made by the oldest and most famous Cava producers in the Champagne method
Codorníu Brut Rosado, Cava, Spain** £19.95
Vibrant, fruity aromas and ripe, summer fruit flavours.
- 15 **J de Telmont Grande Reserve NV, France** £33.50
J de Telmont was founded in 1912 and – four generations later – it is one of the few remaining family-run Champagne houses. This is soft and fruity, with a little classic Champagne yeastiness, and provides super value for money.
- 16 **Sparkling Shiraz, Peter Lehmann Masters Black Queen, Australia** £36.95
Beautifully deep in colour with a persistent fine bead. The bouquet shows hints of satsuma, plum and black cherry leading to an explosion of dark exotic fruits on the palate. A very special sparkling red for times of celebration.
- 17 **Nyetimber Classic Cuvee, England** £45.95
Now this is really special – Nyetimber in West Sussex is arguably the finest wine estate in England. Its vineyards are planted with the three grapes used in Champagne (pinot noir, chardonnay and pinot meunier), which are then made into exquisite sparkling wines using the Champagne method. Complex layers of baked apple, citrus, honey and pastry flavours – the perfect home-grown Champagne alternative.
- 18 **Still family owned and most famous for producing Cristal
Louis Roederer Brut Premier, France** £57.95
Aromas of custard cream biscuits, with hints of dried fruit peel and ripe apples: the palate is rich and elegant.
- 19 **Pol Roger Vintage, France** £98.50
A favourite of Sir Winston Churchill himself, Pol Roger's vintage Champagnes never disappoint, and this is no exception. The 2004 was aged in Pol Roger's deep underground cellars for 8 years before being released, and has developed brioche and honey hints to complement its citrus, white blossom and stone fruit flavours.

ROSÉ WINE

DRY, ELEGANT ROSES

- 20 **Mirabeau Rosé, Côtes de Provence, France** £24.95
Rose-pink with wild strawberry, raspberry and redcurrant aromas: the palate offers a combination of ripe red fruits and zesty apple.

RICH, FRUITY ROSES

- 21 **Alpha Zeta 'R' Rosato, Italy** £3.50 £5.85 £16.95
Leading New Zealand winemaker Matt Thomson is behind this wine, sourcing his corvina grapes from the hills outside Verona, and fermenting them gently at cool temperatures to retain their delicate aromas. Refreshing strawberry, sweet cherry and floral hints abound. The perfect sunshine wine!
- 22 **Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rose, Italy** £4.75 £6.75 £19.50
Classic pink pinot grigio with just a hint of merlot for added depth. Soft and easy-drinking, with strawberry flavours, floral notes and a refreshing citrus zing. Summer in a bottle – and lovely with lighter dishes.

RED WINE

JUICY, EASY-DRINKING, FRUIT-LED REDS

- 23 **La Picoutine Rouge, South France** £3.90 £6.25 £17.95
A light, soft, fruity blend of grenache and carignan grapes from a forward-thinking, quality-focused co-operative in the Languedoc. Brimming with cherry and plum flavours.
- 24 **Rio Alto Merlot, Chile** £4.75 £6.75 £19.50
Classic Chilean merlot – smooth, dark berry fruit with a hint of spice and round, supple body. A tasty, easy-drinking red you can sip all evening.
- 25 **Côtes du Rhône, Les Abeilles Rouge, Jean-Luc Colombo, France** £23.50
Seductive nose of small red fruits, but also coriander and bay leaf. The palate is fresh and silky, the aromas follow through on to the mouth and are prolonged by notes of liquorice and spices. A friendly, supple wine with well-rounded tannins. Les Abeille means the bees and a percentage of the profits from this wine go towards bee conservation projects.

SMOOTH, GENTLY SPICY REDS

- 26 **Kaiken Reserve Malbec, Argentina** £21.95
This estate was set up by the award-winning Montes winery from Chile (we sell their delicious Montes Alpha Chardonnay). The malbec grapes for this wine come from old vines in the premium Mendoza region of Argentina, and the wine is gently aged in French oak. The result is a smooth, ripe, fragrantly fruity wine with rich chocolate and coffee notes – very sippable, especially with red meat or terrines.
- 27 **Navajas Crianza Rioja, Spain** £25.95
The Navajas bodegas has access to excellent grapes and knows how to use them, crafting this quintessential Rioja full of smooth forest fruits, gentle spice and oaky character.

SPICY, PEPPERY, WARMING RED

- 28 **Wirra Wirra 'The Good Catch' Shiraz Cabernet Petit Verdot, Australia** £22.95
This superb, well-respected wine estate was founded in the early 20th century by Robert Strangways Wigley, a cricketer for South Australia. The Good Catch is a vibrant, juicy wine full of cherry and blackberry flavours and spicy oak character. A good match with lamb and beef.
- 29 **Hochar Père et Fils Red, Chateau Musar, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon** £27.50
If you've never tried Lebanese wine, this one will convert you for life. This is made by the legendary Château Musar, using grapes including cabernet sauvignon, grenache and carignan, and is gently aged in oak for 6-9 months. It has an intense, delicious complexity: think rich blackberry and black cherry, silky, sweet spice and earthy, herby hints

INTENSE, CONCENTRATED REDS

- 30 **Bacca Nera Negroamaro-Primitivo, Italy** £20.50
One of our favourite reds on the list – similarly to the Valpolicella, a small amount of the grapes are allowed to dry out to concentrate the flavours, making this a rich, intense, silky wine with supercharged sweet fruit flavour. Super value.
- 31 **Torre del Falasco Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso, Italy** £28.50
A portion of the grapes for this wine is allowed to dry out to fully concentrate the flavours, creating an intense, powerful wine with dark fruit, chocolate and spicy notes. A great value alternative to the much more expensive Amarone.
- 32 **Glen Carlou Paarl Pinot Noir, South Africa** £29.95
A wine that reflects the character of its winemaker – a laid-back but deeply passionate man with a penchant for cigars! Smooth, silky and generous, with strawberry and cherry flavours blending seamlessly with a darker, earthy, smoky tone. A feel-good wine in more ways than one, as the estate is committed to several conservation and community projects.
- 33 **Clos Sainte-Anne, Cotes De Bordeaux, France** £32.95
Medium-bodied with aromas and flavours of plums and blackcurrants, firm yet gentle tannins and a long savoury finish. A classic Bordeaux wine made in a fantastic vintage.

DESSERT WINE

- 34 **Mas de Lavail Maury 'Expression', South France** £3.50
One of southern France's best kept secrets, Maury is a seductive red dessert wine that – once tried – is never forgotten. This is fresh and balanced, with a round, figgy, blackberry-filled character and smooth finish. Very friendly with chocolate.
- 35 **Peter Lehmann Masters Botrytis Semillion, Australia** £3.50
Known as the 'Baron of the Barossa', Peter Lehmann was one of Australia's most celebrated winemakers, and he left behind a legacy of exceptional wines. This is made with the same grape and method as Sauternes, and is a luscious, exquisitely balanced wine with marmalade, honey and citrus flavours.
- 36 **Muscat de Beaumes de Venise, Dme de Fenouillet, Rhone** £4.50
Aromatic, intensely fruity and fresh dessert wine with apricot, pear and honeyed, grapey character. Bags of flavour and vibrancy – it's obvious why this is a French classic.
- 37 **Cypres de Climens, Barsac, Grand Vin de Sauternes, Bordeaux** £6.50
This is the second wine of the celebrated Chateau Climens – one of the finest sweet wine producers in the Sauternes appellation – and is so-called because of the cypress trees lining the vineyards. This wine – made with 100% semillon grapes – has classic Barsac freshness, honeyed apricot and pineapple, and luscious richness.
- 38 **Ben Rye, DOP, Donnafugata, Pantelleria, Italy** £7.50
This is Paul's favourite tippie, even beating the Rusty Spoke!!! Bright amber in colour, it offers an ample and enveloping bouquet characterised by delicious aromas of fresh apricots, with candied citrus peel and notes of Mediterranean sage and evergreen shrubs. It has full fruit flavours and fresh sweetness, with a pleasant vein of acidity and a lingering finish.

DESSERT DRINKS

Triana Pedro Ximenez (PX), Hildago "Nectar" (Sherry) 15.5% 50ml £3.50

A revelation. Intense, rich and opulently sweet with raisin, dried fruit and treacle notes – the ultimate thing to pour over vanilla ice cream and delicious with chocolatey puds.

Caramel, Lemon or Tarragon Old Vodka (Hertfordshire) 40% 25ml £4.50

This is made locally at Church Farm in Ardeley by Merab Salamashvili, whose family has been making vodka for centuries in his native Georgia. The caramel vodka is lovingly created with fresh Ardeley spring water and caramel cooked by Merab himself, and is smooth, sweet without being cloying, and dangerously sippable.

Belle Epoque Vermouth 16.5%, Asti, Italy 50ml £5.00

We think vermouth is the new gin – another revelation! Forget cinzano, this is completely different. Made to a 19th century recipe using white grapes, this vermouth is refined, elegant and full of character. Its luminous golden hue, floral notes and delicate taste means this versatile vermouth can be served as an aperitif, paired with cheese, or even as a dessert wine.

Rusty Spoke (Short Cocktail) 37.5ml £5.25

Delicious nectar sherry married with caramel vodka, poured over ice. This cocktail was invented by Paul and we just love it! The perfect marriage of two of our favourite drinks, indulgent, warming and delicious!

Blackdown Martini (West Sussex) 14.7% 50ml £6.95

Silver Birch Wine made from the sap of the trees surrounding the distillery and is infused with a secret blend of herbs and spices including wormwood and fortified. England's first white Vermouth, full of flavour, smooth and refined. Enjoy over ice or with a tonic.

LOCAL ALE

Bog Brew Beer - from our very own micro-brewery and brewed by Paul's own fair hand

Pail Ale 5.3% 500ml Bottle £5.50

This is a mid-colour IPA combining pale, crystal and Munich malts to give a crisp mouthfeel. Columbus hops added in 2 stages provide peppery, citrus front notes with the British target hops giving a bitter long lasting finish

Porter Potty 4.1% 500ml Bottle £4.50

Deep dark stout using an amount of Chocolate malt, roasted barley and flaked oats to give a rich silky mouthfeel with chocolate hints. The use of Northern Brewer hops for initial bittering and Target English hops added during fermentation give a peppery notes and a lasting finish

Bottoms Up 3.7% 500ml Bottle £4.50

Easy drinking mid-gold ale, in the American style using Galena hops for both bittering and aroma. Pear and grapefruit hues

2mhaard 5.4% 500ml Bottle £5.50

Saison ale with the classic sour notes from the Belgian yeast strain. Dry and crisp with hints of sage and pepper. Great lager alternative."

Bombs Away 6.4% 500ml Bottle £5.75

A double IPA, this ale is our most complex ale, containing Light, Crystal, Munich, Wheat and Dextrin malts. Columbus bittering hops adds peppery citrus notes, whilst late and dry hopping addition of Galena hops adds fruity notes.

BEER

Redchurch Brick Lane London Lager 4.7% £3.85

A typical London style lager.

Meantime Pale Ale 4.3% £3.85

East Anglia is home to the world's finest malting barley and Kent is home to some of the world's best hops. Midway between the two, London is ideally placed to bring them together in a straightforward, clean, long-matured, unpasteurised lager, where all you can taste is malt and hop.

Meantime Chocolate Porter 6.5% £4.95

The natural mocca flavours of the four different roasted malts used to brew this rich, dark beer are complemented by the addition of real chocolate during maturation. Warm, complex and smooth, it has a long, clean finish.

Chapel Down IPA – Curious IPA 5.6% £3.95

Powerfully hoppy India Pale Ale (IPA) is brewed using the finest pale ale malt and three complementary hops, balanced yet powerful IPA.

Chapel Down Lager – Curious Brew 4.7% £3.95

Curious Brew is a truly premium lager for people who love beer. Brewed in England with precision and passion to create a uniquely satisfying, drier, cleaner, fresher lager beer.

CIDER

Chapel Down Cider – Curiously Apple 5.2% £3.95

A premium cider drawing inspiration from winemaking rather than cidermaking. Unlike almost all commercial ciders, there is no concentrate used or water. This is 100% pure Kent apple juice, gently carbonated and extremely refreshing.

Orchard Pig Reveller 4.5% £4.50

A crisp, refreshing cider with a tangy note of freshly squeezed lime in the finish. It has around 30% fewer bubbles than other ciders, making it very drinkable!

Aspalls Cyder Premier Cru 7.0% £5.50

Fruity, dry, racy, thirst-quenching, lip-smacking. Full dry with a sophisticated and elegant floral aroma that captures the essence of an orchard.
